Hydra River Base

The Hydra River Base is located on the banks of the Kicking Horse River. The site is fully equipped with flushing toilets, change rooms, picnic area, volleyball courts and car parking, all available to our rafting clients. We even have a lodge where you can pick up a rafting souvenir or view photos of your rafting adventure.

Directions to River Base from Calgary & Banff

- Travel west on the Trans Canada Highway (Hwy #1) past Banff and Lake Louise.
- Continue driving passed the town of Field. Approximately 20 minutes (29 kms) after Field you will leave Yoho National Park.
- Take the next right turn onto Beaver Foot Road (via underpass, off Hwy), look for Hydra signage.
- Cross over railway tracks and then over a bridge. Turn right onto Kicking Horse Rd. Our site is the first driveway on the right, past the cabins with the red roofs. Look for the Hydra sign.

Hydra River Base is located 15km East of Golden.

Cancellation

No refund will be given if cancellation occurs within 48 hours of the reservation. For group reservations (more than 8 people), no refund will be provided if cancelled within 7 days of tour time.



Upper & Lower Canyon Rafting

Raft every rapid the Kicking Horse has to offer! Starting with calmer rapids on the upper canyon, get to know your fellow rafters while enjoying the spectacular scenery. Then it's onto the lower canyon!

Known for deep canyon walls and mighty rapids, the lower canyon is the most challenging part of the Kicking Horse River. After an intense whitewater ride, the river calms and ends in the town of Golden. This trip is sure to satisfy even the most adventurous thrill seeker!

Enjoy 3 hours of rafting time plus a BBQ lunch.

This trip is restricted to persons 16 years and older. Minimum numbers required. Trip based on water levels. In the event the lower canyon is closed, the Double White water trip will operate. This is an excellent alternative and provides comparable rapids to the Ultimate trip.

Classification of Rapids:

- 1 Class I - Gentle, moving water
- 2 Class II - Small waves
- 3 Class III - Large, continuous series or sets of waves
- 4 Class IV - Large, intense rapids
- 5 Class V - Powerful rapids, very challenging for even the most experienced rafters!
- 6 Class VI - Waterfall!
